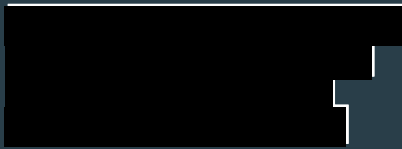

About New Beginning:

New Beginning is a sub-regional acute adolescent unit in London. Its intake is limited to young people aged 13 to 18 whose GP is part of one of the five PCTs that constitute the North Central London health sector (total population 1.18 million, of whom close to 60,000 were of secondary school age, according to government statistics in January 2008). Before New Beginning was set up, there were no acute NHS adolescent beds in the sector.
