

Good standing

What is confirmation of Good Standing?

We send this to overseas regulators and employers to confirm a registrant's good standing. The confirmation will show whether at the time of issuing, there are any restrictions on the registrant's practice.

What information does the confirmation contain?

The confirmation will contain your name, and confirmation of your current registration status.

What is Good Standing?

UKCP defines a registrant to be in good standing if they have met the following criteria:

- 1. Have paid the relevant membership fees to UKCP
- 2. Have not been subject to any form of sanction, suspension or disciplinary censure

If a registrant hasn't met both of these criteria then UKCP will be unable to confirm good standing.

How do I request confirmation of Good Standing?

You can request confirmation of Good Standing by contacting the Membership Team either by email membership@UKCP.org.uk or by writing to: Membership Team, UK Council for Psychotherapy, York House, 221 Pentonville Road, London N1 9UZ.

If you have never been registered with us we can't issue confirmation of Good Standing.

How long does it take to process a confirmation of Good Standing?

We process requests as quickly as possible, usually within ten working days. Please allow as much time as possible for the confirmation to be delivered. We will contact you if we are unable to send the confirmation for any reason.

How long is a confirmation of Good Standing valid for?

These are normally only valid for three months from the date that they are issued.
